### APPEAL FOR WITNESSES

#### **Break-Ins – Dalbeattie**

Overnight Wednesday 6/Thursday 7 May 2010 the premises at Dalbeattie and District Day Centre in Burns Street were the subject of an attempted break-in. Over the same period, attempts have been made to break into the Co-op Pharmacy in High Street, and a small workhouse at the rear of Neilsons the butchers shop in High Street. No entry has been gained to any of the premises however damage has been caused in these attempts.

#### **Vandalism – Newton Stewart**

A parking meter on the Raiders Road, Clatteringshaws, in the Galloway Forest Park has been vandalised sometime over the past week.

#### **Lost Tablets – Dumfries**

Over 100 Clozapine tablets have been lost in the Lovers Walk area of Dumfries sometime on Friday 7 May 2010. Police warn of the dangers of anyone taking medication which is not prescribed for them.

#### **Break-In – Collin**

A house at The Racks in Collin has been broken into some time between Sunday 2 May and Friday 7 May 2010. Taken in the raid were a red and grey Honda petrol lawnmower and green and silver Ryobi petrol trimmer.

#### **Bike thefts – Dumfries**

A black coloured Specialised make mountain bike has been stolen from a house in Rae Street in Dumfries sometime around 1900 hours on Friday 7 May 2010.
