### APPEAL FOR WITNESSES

#### **Diesel theft – Lockerbie**

A quantity of diesel has been stolen from a lorry parked in the yard at Birkshaw Forest, Lockerbie, sometime between 1230 hours on Monday 31 May and 0800 hours on Tuesday 1 June 2010.

#### **Vandalism – Gretna**

An electric fence and a sign have been vandalised at Old Graitney Farm, Gretna, next to the Kirtle Bridge, sometime between Thursday 27 May and Tuesday 1 June 2010.

#### **Theft – Dumfries**

A quantity of cash has been stolen from a purse in a bag at the Caven Arms in Buccleuch Street in Dumfries sometime between 1145 hours and 1440 hours on Tuesday 1 June 2010.

#### **Vandalism – Dumfries**

A grey coloured BMW car parked in the forecourt of Maxwelltown Braes Filling Station in Lochside Road, Dumfries was vandalised sometime between 0500 hours and 1800 hours on Tuesday 1 June 2010. Police want to trace a group of 6 teenage youths, 1 x girl and 5 boys who were seen near the car around 1700 hours that day.

#### **Theft – Dumfries**

Sometime between 2100 hours on Tuesday 1 and 0130 hours on Wednesday 2 June 2010 someone has entered the house of an elderly lady in Hardthorn Road in Dumfries and stolen her handbag and a quantity of costume jewellery. The handbag was black and contained personal items and a cheque book.
