APPEAL FOR WITNESSES

Theft – Auldgirth

Police are investigating a theft of heating oil from a house in Auldgirth sometime between over the past six weeks or so. Over 300 litres of oil has been taken from a tank at the house.

Vandalisms – Annan

A Ford Mondeo car which was parked in the Farmers Den car park in Lady Street in Annan has had its windscreen smashed sometime between 1800 hours on Thursday 10 and 0630 hours on Friday 11 June 2010.

Bike theft – Dumfries

A blue coloured old style bike has been stolen from outside Kirkpatrick Cycle Agents in Queen Street in Dumfries sometime between 0900 hours and 1130 hours on Saturday 12 June 2010. Around 1100 hours two men (not further described) were seen pushing a blue bike down Queen Street.
