### APPEAL FOR WITNESSES

#### **Bike theft – Lockerbie**

A silver coloured mountain bike has been stolen from the rear garden of a house in Douglas Court in Lockerbie sometime overnight Thursday 1/Friday 2 July 2010. The bike was getting rebuilt and is minus the rear wheel.

#### **Bikes theft – Kingholm Quay**

Two bikes, one a silver mountain bike and the other a maroon/purple ladies bike have been stolen from a garden shed at a house in Laghall Court in Kingholm Quay, sometime between 26 June and 2 July 2010.

#### **Vehicles damaged – Heathhall**

Cars in the Anne Arundel Court area of Heathhall have been damaged sometime between 18 June and 1 July 2010. The aerials from a Ford Ka, a Peugeot 207 and a Peugeot 307 car have been broken off and removed, and a Renault Laguna car has also been vandalised.

#### **Windows smashed – Dumfries**

Three windows at Dumfries High School have been smashed sometime overnight Thursday 1/ Friday 2 July 2010.

#### **Disturbance – Whithorn**

Police are investigating the report of a disturbance outside the Queens Arms Hotel in Main Street, Isle of Whithorn, around 0130 hours on Saturday 3 July 2010. At that time a number of persons were involved in a disturbance in which a local 38 year old female received a broken suspected broken arm. It is believe that up to 10 or so person may have been involved in the disturbance and police are appealing for any witnesses to come forward if they can assist wit the enquiry.

#### **Cars damaged – Dumfries**

A silver coloured Mini car was vandalised while parked in the Brooms Rod car park sometime around 0115/0130 hours on Saturday 3 July 2010.

A green coloured Volvo S40 car had windows smashed while it was parked in Criffel Drive in Dumfries sometime overnight Saturday 3/Sunday 4 July 2010.
